We've some great stories for you this month, and, as ever, if you've anything you'd like us to cover or have any questions, please get in touch.





The Blood Cancer UK Forum is a great place for people affected by Blood Cancer to connect and be informed of topics that affect our community.


In a recent survey 96% of people who use our Forum agreed that they have a better understanding of where they can get support and information about blood cancer. You don't even need to register to view content.
